What Is It?

A Rocha USA's Church Partners Program invites congregations across the country to integrate care for God's creation into their discipleship, worship, and witness. Our network of Church Partners shares a common commitment: that care for God's world is an essential expression of following Christ and participating in Christ's ongoing mission to reconcile all things to himself (Col 1:15-20).



Who Is This For?

Any church can become an A Rocha USA Church Partner by taking concrete steps to steward creation through practical action, spiritual formation, giving, or prayer. Once a year, we invite Church Partners to share a story about how they have lived out creation care in their own context—whether it's through habitat restoration, energy stewardship, community gardening, education, or other local initiatives. We welcome churches to financially support A Rocha USA's conservation work. However, giving is not required to become a Church Partner. The emphasis is on shared commitment and participation in a growing national network of churches, who are learning and taking creation care action together.

Sustaining Partners

Churches that give a substantial gift annually to support A Rocha USA's conservation work become Sustaining Partners. This recognizes that financial generosity is itself an act of creation care witness. Their giving helps fund A Rocha USA's habitat restoration, species monitoring, and creation care education projects, and the growth of this network. Churches can, of course, designate their gifts to go towards the specific purpose closest to their congregation's heart.



Keystone Partners

Ecologists use the term "keystone species" for organisms — like Yellowstone's grey wolf, or oak trees — whose presence supports a remarkable diversity of other life. Keystone Partners play an analogous role in the network: churches that take a deeper step of collaboration by hosting joint events with local congregations and A Rocha USA (events like creation care workshops, community service projects, or educational gatherings) to inspire and equip others in their community to live out faithful care for the environment. The Live Oak — A Rocha USA's own symbol — is itself a keystone species, sheltering and sustaining remarkable biodiversity beneath its canopy. Keystone Partners receive that same quality of investment from us: not just resources and communications, but a genuine, ongoing relationship with A Rocha USA staff who are committed to their flourishing.
